

SIMULATE RECEIVING QUESTIONS



Prof

Sets up the simulation in RISE, iSpring, Moodle, PDF, Word document, Storyline (it's just a link!) mailto:emmyhuot@gmail.com?subject =Question

Student

Selects the link. The e-mail popup will appear, and they type their question.

Prof

Receives the question. Posts the question and the answer on Moodle.

Student Has all their questions answered!

Prof

Doesn't have to repeat themselves!






